## 2nd Ohio Cavalry, Company K.

### Overview:

Benjamin Wamsley was born in the year 1845. When he was 18 he fought in the Civil War on the Union side. Wamsley was part of the 2nd Ohio Cavalry in Company k. He entered the army on March 10, 1863 and fought for one year. Wamsley's rank was Private throughout his time in the service. He mustered out with the the company a year later. Benjamin eventually died September 16, 1869.

The 2nd Ohio Cavalry was brought together in Cleveland, Ohio and also at Camp Dennison. It was organized from August to October in 1861. It was mustered in for 3 years and during those 3 years it was under the command of Charles Doubleday.
