

Horace E. Taplin

Born in Corinth, Orange County, Vermont around 1836

Worked with his Father, Gouldsbourn on the family farm

Enlisted on December 11, 1861 at age 25

Promoted to Sergeant on Sept. 11, 1864



Fought in the Battle of Cedar Creek on Oct. 19, 1864

Discharged on June 28, 1865

Married Mary Skinner on Nov. 23 1870

Moved to Illinois before 1900



Died on March 13, 1906 at around the age of 70
